of Epiphany. It


recognizes the revelation of Jesus Christ to the entire world as represented by the coming of the Magi to worship the Christ child (Matt. 2).


# Statistics From Our HUMC Online Ministry

### **Trustees**

Trustees have been working on a plan for projects we would like to see completed in the future. Trustees are currently working to assign budget costs to these projects so we can plan ahead to be good stewards of the congregation's financial resources.

- Handicap restroom facility and/or renovations of current bathrooms to meet ADA specifications.
- Repairs and maintenance of the organ and associated equipment.
- Repairs to parking lot and resurfacing of "Shirley Street" parking area.
- Assessment of and possible replacement of Fellowship Hall and Sanctuary lighting.
- Possible acquisition of bank parking lot on North East side of church. Feel free to ask questions of any of your Trustees.

### Stephen Ministry

As you may be aware from our Rally Day celebration, our Stephen Ministry (SM) team has grown with the addition of two newly commissioned Stephen Ministers, Chip Houghton and Jack Hubbard. More recently, Scott met with Lynda Atkinson, who became a member of HUMC last year. Lynda is a commissioned Stephen Minister but never had the chance to minister to a care receiver for a myriad of reasons. She is now wishing to join our SM team and she and Scott are meeting to review the coursework she went through and decide how best to go forward with an SM "refresher" program for her.

In the meantime, we once again would like to ask all of you to remain mindful about what Stephen Ministers do, which is provide one-on-one care to people who are experiencing difficult times in their lives. Our role is to offer emotional and spiritual support and to help people process their feelings. Stephen Ministers typically meet with their care receivers about an hour a week. These meetings are private and confidential. They are carefully chosen to be compassionate, good listeners and to take meetings seriously.

Some examples of situations that a Stephen Minister might help with include: grief, divorce, job loss, chronic or terminal illness, relocation, hospitalization, death of a loved one, severe financial setback, depression, struggles I faith, deployment of a loved one.

So, the Stephen Minister team would like to ask you all to help us out by being "lookouts" for us. In other words, if you know of anyone who you think may benefit from our help, please let a Stephen Minster know.

Level 2 Snow Emergency – Worship will be held for all those who choose to attend if they feel that they can travel safely. Choir Director may cancel Choir at his discretion. All other non-worship church activities are cancelled.

Level 3 Snow Emergency – Worship and all other activities will be cancelled for the day even if the Level 3 is lifted part way through the day.

We want everyone to remain safe and healthy. (If you have any doubt, stay put – the Lord understands!)


