Beginning the first week in September, we will be taking a look at the *Social Principles Of The United Methodist Church 2025 – 2028*. (There are copies for you in the Welcome Center, please be sure to grab one.) Something from each section will be the “jumping off point” for our weekly sermons. For those who wish to dive deeper, there will be a discussion/study session on Tuesdays from 10:00 – 11:15 a.m.

Wondering what the Social Principles are? “At their best, the Social Principles articulate our ethical aspirations for the common good in our public policies and personal commitments. Through them, we seek to love God with our whole heart, mind, soul, and strength and to desire for our neighbors what we desire for ourselves.” (p.7) “The Social Principles provide our most recent official summary of stated convictions that seek to apply the Christian vision of righteousness to social, economic, and political issues.” (p. 13)

Will we all agree with everything in the Social Principles? I’m guessing not. But... “Rather than see differences and controversies as a barrier to community, we are invited to indeed accept difference and disagreements as ‘evidence that God is not yet finished in sculpting us to be God’s people’ (the Preamble).” (p. 15)

Indeed, God is not yet finished with us! And that is reason for HOPE! HOPE for today! HOPE for tomorrow! HOPE for the future!

We are Huron United Methodist Church! WooHoo! We are disciples of Jesus, the Christ, followers of the living God, and sharers of the WORD! May God continue to encourage, empower, and equip us as we strive “to make [and mature] disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world!”




## Sunday Morning Worship

## LIFT Starting September 3rd!

You are invited to join LIFT (Living In Faith Together). This is our evening of multigenerational learning/fellowship. We have classes, conversation, puzzles, foosball, and games. LIFT is set to begin on Wednesday, September 3rd. This is a perfect time to grow your faith, get reacquainted with old friends, as well as meet new ones.

Doors open at 5:00 p.m. and learning/fellowship groups begin at 5:30 p.m. We are offering a confirmation class for students entering the 4th grade and above, UM Youth Fellowship for those who have recently been confirmed, a children's class called Deep Blue, and an adult group.

Children's classes are back with a series called Deep Blue. This awe-inspiring resource incorporates adventure, exciting stories, science experiments, and more into a living-faith experience! Children will explore families in the Bible, learn how today's faith families care for children as they grow, build loving relationships, and find out what it means to be part of God's family! The Deep Blue curriculum includes: weekly session plans, Bible verses, games, art, worship, prayers, activity sheets, posters, and interactive Bible stories. Each week, children are encouraged to dig deeper and apply the Bible story and lesson to their daily lives.

This fall, our adults will continue on with season 4 of The Chosen. "The Chosen is a groundbreaking historical drama based on the life of Jesus Christ (Jonathan Roumie), seen through the eyes of those who knew him. Set against the backdrop of Roman oppression in first-century Israel, the seven-season show shares an authentic and intimate look at Jesus' revolutionary life and teachings." – [TheChosen.tv](https://TheChosen.tv).

Pastor P. leads the Confirmation Class (4th graders and older) in their preparation for church membership vows with lessons in UM Church history, use of their Bible, and more. They meet in Room 10.

UM Youth Fellowship meets in Room 6 & 7. This group is for tweens and teens – mostly post-Confirmation kids. They have a brief lesson or activity and then plenty of time to play games and enjoy fellowship with each other. Beth Anne McFarland chaperones this group.

At 6:30 p.m. we will gather together in the Fellowship Hall for dinner, and at 7:00 p.m. there is Chancel Choir rehearsal and continued fellowship. Come for any or all of the evening!


## Chancel Choir
